

IAPH Training Scholarship



What is IAPH Training Scholarship?

"IAPH Training Scholarship" is a financial assistance scheme to assist those at IAPH member (Regular) ports in developing countries to receive advanced and short-duration (a week or so) port training courses/seminars at IAPH-affiliated training institutes overseas. For each calendar year, a maximum of four scholarships (US\$2,500) may be granted, which should be used only to cover the tuition/course fee.

Currently the following five organizations are recognized as IAPH-affiliated training institutes:

- PSA Institute (Singapore)
- IPER (Le Havre, France)
- APEC (Antwerp, Belgium)
- IBC Global Academy (distance learning)
- UNESCO-IHE (Netherlands)

In case any IAPH member port offers a port training program through its subdivision or any Associate member offering a short duration course for international participants, it may possibly be considered as an IAPH-affiliated training institute.

1. Who can apply?

A successful applicant should be a young and full-time staff of IAPH member ports (Regular Members) in **developing countries (See Attachment 1)**, but excluding those staff of central government ministry or agency not actually engaged in port management/operations.

Needless to say, full payment of IAPH membership dues by your host port is a prerequisite for your application.

2. How to apply?

1) Submission of application form to IAPH

An applicant should complete and submit an application form to IAPH Secretariat in the recommended format. (**Attachment 2**)

2) Criteria and selection of application:

Applications are processed and screened by the Tokyo secretariat on a first-come/first-served basis, but carefully considering that one scholarship is awarded to one IAPH member port in a two-year period. In case a plural number of applications are submitted from a single member port, then it will be referred to the IAPH Coordinator of that port. The point is that this program is made available to as many IAPH member ports in developing countries as possible and, as such, preference is always given to an application coming from an IAPH member port who has never been awarded a scholarship.

3. Registration for and enrolment in the approved training program

The approved applicant makes all necessary arrangements for registering for and enrolling in the approved course, including payment of the tuition fee. As international travel is required, the applicant is recommended to seek support from his/her port, including permission for leave and obtaining visa.

4. Reimbursement of the course fee

The course or tuition fee paid by the approved applicant or his/her host port is to be reimbursed up to US\$2,500 by IAPH Secretariat, only upon receipt of the following documents from the beneficiary submitted within three months of the conclusion of the training involved.

- Short report on attendance*
- Original copy of receipt of the course fee, preferably accompanied by a certificate of attendance issued by the training institute
- Details of bank account, to which reimbursement is to be made

*Required forms are to be provided to the approved applicant.
