The sustainable development objective of the Port is to “satisfy the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs”. Sustainability is broken down into three areas: economic, social and environmental.


In order to improve the competitiveness, it is vital for the Port to improve the efficiency of its services, and to have a more attractive offer than the competitors in terms of price, security, liability, quality, ...

Growth is not an end in itself: the purpose of the Port is to create wealth for its area of influence. In the current portuari context, competitiveness will only be achieved through a critical mass of traffic.


