
WHO IS THIS CHECKLIST FOR?

This IAPH Terminal Call Checklist is intended for terminals that facilitate marine-fuelled vessels at their berths. It has been developed specifically for terminal or site operators to manage operations involving vessels carrying alternative clean marine fuels, which are often flammable and toxic liquids or gases, intended for use in propulsion or auxiliary engines, with or without bunkering operations while alongside.

The checklist aims to ensure that a clean marine-fuelled vessel's fuel system does not pose extra risks for the terminal and its operations, and that the vessel can be safely accommodated. It provides the terminal with advance information regarding potential restrictions for both vessel and terminal operations.

If bunkering operations are planned, parties involved should use the IAPH bunker checklists along with this terminal call checklist.

Safe operations depend on clear communication among all parties and strict adherence to agreed safety procedures throughout all stages. This checklist helps to ensure that all appropriate safeguards for decreasing the risks of the clean marine fuels on board the vessel are in place. It can be used prior to vessel arrival or by terminal staff upon arrival.

The checklist has been developed in cooperation with maritime industry partners that have expertise in alternative fuelled vessels.
