<u>Summary description (in plain langage)</u>: This agreement deals with the procedure of Port State Control in Latin American region. Each Contracting Party have to establish and maintain a system of Port State Control in order to ensure that, without discrimination as to flag, foreign merchant ships calling at the ports of its state comply with the standards laid down (<u>section 1.2</u>).

Also, the Contracting Parties have to achieve 15% annual inspection rate per country within 3 years (section 1.3).

<u>Applicability (situation of ratification):</u> The present agreement shall enter into force for each and every Maritime Authority on the date notification in this repect is given to the ROCRAM Secretariat (section 9).

<u>Stakes for ports:</u> Ports are strictly involved in the control of foreign ships entered in their ports (<u>section 3</u>). The Port State Control Officers are entitled to survey ships. They are liable for the inspection of those ships:

- Passenger ships, ro-ro ships, Bulk Carriers.

- Ships which may present a special hazard.
- Ships which have had several recent deficiencies
